An exhibitor’s participation fee of \$50.00 is payable to “Bumblebee Creative Social Enterprises”, together with this document, as your signed exhibition policy.


Artisans are required to take complete responsibility for their items and indemnify Windows of the World and associated organisation against any damage or loss to items associated with the exhibition.
