Plasticity Rio 2012 will discuss the solutions and new technologies around plastic, with the end benefactor being our environment and our daily lives. This is a great opportunity to make a difference in the way that plastic is designed, used, and reused, both through sharing innovative ideas and highlighting the practices of current leaders in sustainable plastic use.

Plasticity Rio will be held on June 21st at the Victoria Jockey Club in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. The event will be followed by an evening networking event with special entertainment. On June 22nd we will host a half-day working session with stakeholders interested in PET bottles. This session will work to provide solutions for the stakeholder community to take home from Rio, empowering them to initiate some of the winning ideas from our sustainable design competition, Capturing Gold.

Join the Competition!

Capturing Gold is a competition to address two big challenges — 1) how to capture large quantities of "gold" (PET plastic bottles) on a long term, sustained basis, and 2) how to use that material in innovative ways. At Plasticity, we look at PET in the same way that others look at gold, hence the name. We want the world to come up with new ideas for capturing and reusing that PET gold for other purposes. Capturing all of the "gold" is as complex a challenge as it is ambitious, but we believe it can be done.

Generating the right solutions, though, require a certain kind of genius. We call it the genius of many. It's the kind of genius that happens when a diverse group of minds come together to tackle a complex problem. That's why this

year's challenge is as much collaboration as it is competition. And that's why we've created the open source, collaborative idea platform we're calling Capturing Gold. Check it out!
