The votes are in, the judging process complete, and the results final! This year the Tony Blair Faith Foundation asked filmmakers, aged 14-18, to create a film with the topic "Let me show you how my faith inspires me". The response was overwhelming and far exceeded our expectations.

The Faith Shorts 2011 competition saw entrants from five continents. Young people from countries including India, Egypt, Italy, Argentina, Canada, Pakistan, UK, New Zealand, Lebanon, USA, Nigeria, Singapore, and the Philippines sent through their expressions of faith through film. Our judges, including Hugh Jackman, Jet Li, Anil Kapoor, Amr Khaled, Rabbi David Rosen and Tony Blair, had a great time watching the films and a hard time deciding on their favourites!

With everything from rap music videos to 'green' global messages, this year's film submissions have really broadened the reach of the relationship between interfaith dialogue and the arts going on around the world by young people today, reaching new and wider audiences through social media sites.
