H.R college of Commerce and Economics started a **“Mentor - mentee” initiative** under the **Global Dialogue Foundation** program. It was a **6-month teaching** program that started in August. HR College students mentored students of VBM and MSPT School where underprivileged students study. Their mission was to help them with personality development, confidence-building and a lot more. HR College students went to these schools every week for two hours on Saturdays to provide them with lessons. They built the curriculum and tried to tailor it to the under resourced students needs.



• In the first month they covered core activities of **skill- building** such as developing self-confidence, challenging social taboos, honing English language skills, personal grooming and hygiene. Then they moved forward to more **practical lessons** such as group discussions, presentations etc. The mentors are now working with the children to put up a talent show so as to **showcase a greater level of confidence**. The result of this endeavour was that the children who first didn't even speak up in their own classrooms are now putting up a full show on their own efforts with the support and guidance from their mentors. They've chosen the theme of cultural diversity, peace and growth for the talent show.



About **15 BMS students** of HR college acted as Mentors and each of them had a group of about **25 children** to guide and mentor. They took up various activities with them like personality development, English conversation, and many more to develop their self-confidence and make them smarter and ready to face college life once they finish school.
