

Antic Macedonian alphabet revealed on Rosetta Stone

After almost ten years of work on the Rosetta Stone, Academician Tome Bosevski (MANU) and Prof. Dr. Aristotel Tentov revealed the unknown text and alphabet on the Rosetta Stone.

"We have defined the alphabet, it completely matches the consonants of the modern Macedonian language. Today, with little effort, we could understand the language of the Antic Macedonians", said Tome Bosevski as they unveiled the script from the Rosetta stone.
